

GREEK WEEK 2010 RULES AND POINTS

General Rules

- Rep meetings are mandatory, at least one rep from each pairing must attend.
 - o 20 points if both reps attend, 10 points if one rep attends.
- Posting posters are mandatory.
 - o 10 points if both reps posted, 5 points if one rep posted.
 - o Teams can post additional posters during Greek Week for 10 points each, must email pictures as proof of each poster, maximum 10.
- Exchanges
 - o 125 points – must be done prior to Greek Week, can provide proof of prior event this school year.
- Shirt Sales
 - o 1 points per shirt purchased for the total shirts in each pairing.

General Rules in Effect During Greek Week

- Day and Night
 - o Winners will be determined and awarded points as described later for each event.
 - o Participation points will be awarded based on signing in as determined by the participation points chart.
 - o Only sign ins during the first half of an event will be counted.
- Attire
 - o Greek Week, All Greek, Chapter Shirts, and Letters are ENCOURAGED as per the schedule, but no additional points will be awarded for attire.
- Sign Ins
 - o The point of sign ins is to support the Greek Week events.
 - o Sign ins will be REMOVED at the ½ mark of each event, but may be kept out longer at the discretion of Greek Week exec.
 - o We reserve the right to END sign ins at a decent time should an event end earlier/later than the scheduled time.
 - o There would be no point to keep a sign in AFTER an event was ended just to have a sign in, the whole idea is to support the events as they happen.

Participation Point System

- This year we have a new point system for participation.
- In order to accommodate both small and large chapters, points will be awarded based on BOTH the number of members that show up and the percentage of their chapter.
- Small chapters are at a disadvantage because they physically have less members in a straight “one point per person” system.
- Larger chapters are at a disadvantage in a “percentage system” since for example it is much harder to bring out 75% of a 100 person chapter than 75% of a 50 person chapter.
- This system combines the best aspects of both.
- The reasonable “goal percentages” based on past participation lie around roughly 45% participation.

Tuesday

- Day: Greek Week Kick Off BBQ
 - Where: Anteater Plaza, When: 11am – 2pm
 - Points for this event will be determined only off of participation, there is no actual competition.
 - Chapters MUST set up their booth spots to receive any points, however.

- Night: Tug-of-War
 - Where: ARC Fields, When: 6pm – 8pm
 - Members will participate in a tug-of-war tournament.
 - There will be a men's bracket and a women's bracket.
 - Each chapter may enter a maximum of 6 members to play.
 - Chapters are guaranteed 2 games and will enter the losers bracket to be eligible for less points if they lose their first game.
 - The game ends when the flag on the center of the rope is pulled beyond the designated markers.
 - Winners Bracket
 - 1st – 300 pts, 2nd – 200, 3rd – 100, 4th – 50, 5th – 25
 - Losers Bracket
 - 1st – 150 pts, 2nd – 100, 3rd – 50

Wednesday

- Day: Canned Castle Philanthropy
 - Where: Anteater Plaza, When: 11am – 2pm
 - Pairings are to build the most creative sculpture or castle using new, sealed, canned food only.
 - Minimum 200 cans to participate.
 - Structures cannot exceed 10 ft in height.
 - Pairings may only “build” or touch the cans from a 11am – 1pm window.
 - The castles will be judged on aesthetics, size, and creativity:
 - 1st – 300 pts, 2nd – 200, 3rd – 100, 4th – 50, 5th – 25
 - 1 point per can will also be awarded for each can starting at the 201st can, with a maximum of 200 points awarded in this category.

- Night: Snow Sledding
 - Where: Aldrich Park, When: 8pm – 10pm
 - Pairings will enter teams of 3 men and 3 women to participate.
 - Pairings will be divided into 2 heats of teams, with 5 teams at a time.
 - Participants will be given one sled per team.
 - When instructed to start, each team member must complete 3 rides down the snow slope (18 total per team), meaning they must run back up to the top after each run to pass on the sled.
 - Once these 18 laps are completed, teams will run down to the finish point to mark the finish of their relay.
 - We reserve the right to score heats separately if there are major differences between them due to differing snow/sled conditions between each heat. This will ensure fairness that each heat is ranked compared to comparable competition.
 - The overall fastest completion times will win points:
 - 1st – 300 pts, 2nd – 200, 3rd – 100, 4th – 50, 5th – 25

Thursday

- Day: Bench Press Lift Off
 - Where: Anteater Plaza, When: 11am – 2pm
 - Members from each pairing will attempt to bench press the bar and weight as many times as possible in one set.
 - A pause longer than 2 seconds is considered an end to the set.
 - Men will bench press 135 lbs and women 45 lbs (the bar).
 - The total number of reps per pairing will be divided by the number of participants and the highest average will win.
 - Pairings must have at least 40 participants to be eligible for points.
 - Points will be awarded as follows:
 - 1st – 300 pts, 2nd – 200, 3rd – 100, 4th – 50, 5th – 25

- Night: Cardboard Boat Race
 - Where: ARC Pools, When: 7pm – 9pm
 - Boat must be made in advance and brought to race.
 - ONLY duct tape, packaging tape, and cardboard may be used.
 - Permanent marker can ONLY be used for designs on the boat, washable marker, spray paint, etc, will result in DISQUALIFICATION.
 - Paddles will be provided for each team
 - One member from each pairing will paddle the boat to one end of the pool and back, and then switch to a new member of the team, this must be a guy/girl switch.
 - The team that completes the most laps within 15 minutes will win first, then second, etc.
 - Boats will be split into 2 heats and race in 2 separate groups of 6.
 - Boats will be judged for aesthetics and ranked as well.
 - Points for most laps will be awarded:
 - 1st – 300 pts, 2nd – 200, 3rd – 100, 4th – 50, 5th – 25
 - Points for aesthetics will be awarded:
 - 1st – 150 pts, 2nd – 100, 3rd – 50

Friday

- Day: Basketball Shoot Out
 - Where: Anteater Plaza, When: 11am – 2pm
 - Members from each pairing will attempt to make as many basketball shots as they can in 60 seconds based on the timer in the interactive basketball machine.
 - The total number of MADE shots per pairing will be divided by the number of participants and the highest average will win.
 - Participants may only go once.
 - Due to the length of each person's round, chapters may only send 5 men and 5 women to participate for a total of 10.
 - Sign ins are tentative for this event and will be announced Thursday evening if they will be happening.
 - Points will be awarded as follows:
 - 1st – 300 pts, 2nd – 200, 3rd – 100, 4th – 50, 5th – 25
